

If working in uniform, you must be in compliance with SDG approved uniform standards. You will be asked to stand down if not in compliance.

If working level 4, you must not wear anything that could be deemed inappropriate or offensive. You should always look and act professional.

Uniform shirt must be black tactical polo style with SDG logo over left breast side and name on right side. The website URL is small across the back collar. All must be in same color listed and use the same font and size. Your name must be last name, but first initial is ok.

Name-Font is Brantford New .45" and the Madeira thread no. 1950.

Pants are Tan, Khaki or Coyote full length Tac pants. No jeans allowed.

Boots must be black boots or shoes. Do not have to be shineable, but must be in good condition.

Jackets are black plain jacket must have logo on both sleeves, badge displayed on left breast and "security" and name on left. You can make all velcro so that it can be removed when off duty or level 4.

Under shirt should be black with no lettering or design showing.

Head coverings-Stocking caps must be solid black. Under armor logo or Nike swish is allowed. Caps are black with SDG logo centered in front. Must be worn forward facing if in uniform.

Any gloves must be black.

Duty belt can be leather or nylon, but nylon is preferred. All black or silver gear. Must be secured to belt and all equipment must be approved.

ASP may be worn for all guards qualified on ASP.

Cuffs must be silver or Black. Hinge or swivel are approved. Must be secured.

Pepper spray is Sabre Red and guard must be trained on prior to carrying.

Conforming to SDG dress code and approved equipment is non-negotiable. Anyone found in violation of SDG policy will be de-commissioned or relieved of service. It is important to not only yourself, but also the other Sheepdogs that we maintain our standards and professionalism.
