

### Level 3

Anytime you are going to wear the distinctive security uniform, SDG must be on agreement or contract to provide security service at the venue. Anytime the uniform is worn, it must be the entire uniform. You are NOT authorized to wear the security shirt with jeans. Your boots must be black and badge must be shown around your neck or on your gun belt next to your firearm. Not all agreements must be written, but they must be made with the owner (David Riggall) and the venue person of authority. You may print and send the form from the portal to the venue and have it signed and forwarded to me. Once it is received, you may be scheduled in uniform during any time that the venue pre-determines is approved.

### Level 4

"PURSUANT TO SECTION 30.06, PENAL CODE (TRESPASS BY **HOLDER OF A LICENSE TO CARRY** A CONCEALED HANDGUN) A PERSON LICENSED UNDER SUBCHAPTER H, CHAPTER 411, GOVERNMENT CODE (CONCEALED HANDGUN LAW), MAY NOT ENTER THIS PROPERTY WITH A CONCEALED HANDGUN."

Holder of a license to carry is a "license" that follows you as a person. The rules of LTC state that you must not pass a sign with the above verbiage, you cannot carry in a place that derives 50% or more of it's income from alcohol sales, public schools (premise-inside), etc.

You should hold an LTC which under the color of the LTC law, you must obey these laws. The difference is that you also hold a personal protection officer "commission". Commission allows you to go into any location, regardless of LTC rules, as long as you are "on duty" and with the person(s) you are on duty to protect. This does not mean that you can hang out at the bar with your protected person and drink. If you are "on duty" you must be working. You are authorized to carry if you are on duty and with your protected person in a public school, at a bar or in an establishment posting signage.

### Broken down

Anytime you carry a gun under the color of private security bureau, including SDG insurance and protection, you must be authorized and on duty. Team leads report hours to SDG. If you wear the uniform, it must be the complete uniform and at a location that is on agreement with SDG. If you are working as a PPO, you may follow your protected person to any location in TX as long as it is not federal ground or otherwise prohibited (not including LTC rules) during the hours of that shift.

All other times, when you are off duty, you follow the rules of LTC. It is not a bad idea to carry a cover shirt or jacket so that you can cover your uniform and carry under LTC protection going to and from work anytime.
